Cell Phone Policy:

- Students in grades Pre-Kindergarten-5th are not allowed to possess any device during school hours. If a student has an IEP exception, they may use the device with preferential seating and under the strict guidelines of the classroom teacher.
- Students in grades 6th-12th may not possess cell phones and other electronic devices between arrival and dismissal. There will be a place in the office to put the phone during the day. If need arises to use the phone to contact parents, the student may use it in the office. If a student has an IEP exception, they may use the device with preferential seating and under the strict guidelines of the classroom teacher.
- Students may not use headphones during school or on any school activity which includes sports games, field trips, and other extracurricular activities.
- Consequences for violation:
 - Confiscation of personal property to be returned at the end of the school day and 20 demerits issued (1st offense)
 - Confiscation of personal property to be returned to parent or guardian and 20 demerits issued (2nd offense)
