Pre-K - 5th

Due to the active nature of the elementary classes, we don't adhere to a specific dress code. Please refer to the Philosophy of Dress as a guideline in choosing the proper clothing that is modest, loose fitting, and in good repair. The elementary students will follow the hair and makeup section of the high school dress code.

$6^{th} - 12^{th}$

Please refer to the Philosophy of Dress as a guideline in choosing the proper clothing. These are the specifics of what is acceptable for wear within the context of CCA.

Bottoms

- Dress pants, jeans, cargo pants, or skirts
 - > Pants must be free of holes
 - > Pants must be loose fitting
 - Skirts must be knee length or longer
- Shorts & Capris (dress, cargo, or jean)
 - May be worn in August-October & April-June
 - Must be no more than 4" above the knees and loose fitting

<u>Tops</u>

- Non-sheer, short or long sleeved button front collared shirt or polo shirt
- Hoodless sweaters that are worn over a collared shirt
- 1/4 zip pullovers that do not need a collared shirt underneath

Footwear

• Dress shoes, dress boots, flip-flops, sneakers, or sandals

<u>Accessories</u>

- Boys
 - Religious head coverings
 - Reasonable necklaces and rings
- Girls
 - Religious head coverings
 - Reasonable piercings, necklaces and rings

Hair and Makeup

- Boys
 - Naturally colored hair trimmed in a neat and well kept appearance with no pony tails, buns, or other faddish styles
 - Clean-shaven with sideburns that may extend to the bottom of the earlobes
- Girls
 - Naturally colored hair trimmed in a neat appearance
 - Makeup applied that enhances the natural look

PE Dress

- Loose fitting short sleeved or long sleeved t-shirt
- Loose fitting warm-up or sweatpants
- Loose fitting shorts that are no more than 4" above the knee
- Correctly fitting and secured sneakers
